Scriptures: John 8:31-32; 14:16; 16:7; 2 Cor. 3:17-18

Bottom Line: The Holy Spirit is not just to be known about, but experienced

John 16:7

v. 7 - Do we believe that it's actually better that we have the Holy Spirit versus Jesus in physical form with us?

John 8:32

v. 32 - The truth and God's promise are what brings us into a greater measure of freedom in our lives.

John 14:16

v. 32 - The Holy Spirit lives inside us and is here to help us.

The Holy Spirit

- Is our helper
- Is meant to be experienced
- Brings us into greater freedom

LISTENING

Check in with everyone, see how the week has been. Give each person your attention, engage with what they're saying. If you're having trouble talking about your week, here are some things to talk about

- What fears have you had this week?
- How did you overreact this week?
- How have you experienced God's goodness this week?
- What/who are you praying for this week?

DISCUSSION QUESTIONS

1. If you could spend a day with anyone from history, who would you spend the day with? What would you do? What would you talk to them about? What would you want to know?
2. What's your perspective on the Holy Spirit? What do you think about Him?
3. Do you believe that it's better to have the Holy Spirit than to have Jesus here with you?
4. How have you experienced the Spirit's work in your own life? (This is tied-in to your understanding of who the Spirit is and what He does).
5. At what time of your day do you most often need a reminder to engage the Spirit as your helper and counsellor?

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
