Appetizer

5. Read **Matthew 25:31-40**. How could putting this teaching into action help remedy a self-absorbed mindset like Belshazzar's?

1. Where has God been leading you or warning you? Have you listened and obeyed, or are you ignoring Him?
2. What is your next step towards listening and obeying God? Is it intentionally listening for God? Is it doing what you're told? Something else?

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
