Bottom Line: Serve one another

The Background of 3 John

John is writing to Gaius: commending him for the way he is walking out the truth as a follower of Jesus, and encouraging him to show hospitality to the people John is sending to preach the real gospel.

3 John 9-15

In the second part of the letter, John warns against Diotrephes, the leader of this home church, who is bad-talking John, refusing to welcome these preachers, and kicking out the people who do welcome them.

V.9-10 - Serve One Another

We have been left an example by Christ in the way He served us (v. 9)

- Matthew 23:11-12

Honour the Apostles authority (v. 9)

Help meet the needs of others (v. 10)

- **Follow what is good - hospitality (v. 11)**
