The Intermediary State

For Those Who Have Died

Soul Sleep: Those who have died are resting until the resurrection (Eccl. 9:5; 1 Thess. 4:13)

Conscious with Christ: those who have died are awake with Christ (Phil. 1:23-24; Rev. 6:9-11)

"I'll see you in a second!": Time ceases to be, everyone enters eternity simultaneously

For Those Who are Alive - Luke 16:19-31
