Bottom Line: How we treat each other depends on how we see each other

"We are being conditioned to mistrust each other, especially those in authority. We must focus on building life-giving relationships that bridge the generation gaps because there is a richness and unity that comes in discipling each other."

Why Intergenerational Friendships?

- Wisdom
- Humility
- A stronger faith

Challenges of Intergenerational Friendships

- Social awkwardness
- Cynical stereotypes
- Lack of common ground

What Can I Do?

- Take a relational inventory
- Ask someone from another generation to teach you something
- Identify faith champions for your children
- Take digital sabbaths

LISTENING

Have someone in your group share something about their week. They could answer one of the following questions:

- What was a big challenge or problem you faced this week? How did you handle it?
- Where did you experience God this week? Or where do you wish you had experienced God this week?
- Based on your life experience this week, what do you think God is trying to teach you right now? What is He trying to build in you?

After the person shares, the group can respond. Make sure you let them know you heard them: tell them what you heard, offer wise advice where it's asked for, share from your own experience as well.
