Bottom Line: Through faith in Jesus, we no longer fear death or judgment

Disclaimer: We can have different opinions on the details of the afterlife and still love each other and Jesus.

Evidence of the Afterlife

Paranormal, Reasonable, Intuitive, Jesus (Matt 10:28; Mark 8:36)

Judgment in the Bible

We will all be judged by God, and this is good news!

- There will be justice
- I am freed to love others
- God is the perfect judge

Jesus offers us assurance for that judgment

- Jesus becomes the perfect sacrifice for our sins
- We share in His life and His right standing
- Eternal life starts now

- Chose to trust in Jesus Christ to have assurance
- Let the focus on the reality of death recalibrate your life
- Lead with love, not judgment
