Bottom Line: The world will see the Church as it really is when we fully embrace the **NEW** and let go of the **OLD**

The Passover - Old and New Covenants

Throughout all of Church history, we have been mixing and matching pieces of the Old Covenant with the New Covenant that Jesus initiated, and it has always gotten us into trouble.

Galatians 5: The Gospel = Jesus + Nothing

When we learn to accept just how completely and fully we have been reconciled to God because of Jesus, we will stop worrying about whether we're good with God, and start focusing on our relationship with each other.
