Change Opens Us Up to Hear God

We all know we should pray, many of us don't do it very often or with much intention. But when a crisis hits, nobody has to tell us to pray.

The Bible tells story after story of people's lives changing trajectory in a moment of transition because God got hold of them and they listened.

Lessons on Being Teachable from Paul

Paul starts off unteachable. It's only through crisis and change that he opens up to learn something new.

We tend to isolate ourselves in times of transition (maybe we feel safer that way). But God used **community** to make Paul teachable, make him aware of the Spirit, and help him grow.

Take-Aways

- God never wants you to stop growing (Phil. 1:6)
- You are the most capable of growth in the midst of change
- Your growth depends on your ability to embrace change

 - b. What is God teaching you through this?
 - c. Who is helping you walk through it?

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
