



**CRAFT/ACTIVITY: FOOD MOBILES** 

Students will make mobiles to recall key events from the story.

#### **MATERIALS**

- 1. 67 lb. White Cardstock
- 2. Mobile Pattern (two pages)
- 3. Crayons, Markers, or Colored Pencils
- 4. Scissors
- 5. Yarn
- 6. Hole Punch



#### **DIRECTIONS**

- 1. Make copies of the mobile patterns onto 67lb. cardstock for each student (two pages per student).
- 2. Have students color each piece of the mobile with crayons, markers, or colored pencils.
- 3. Have students cut out the pieces on the solid black lines.
- 4. Punch holes in each piece of the mobile through the black holes.
- 5. Attach mobile pieces with yarn.

#### FOR DISCUSSION

As students are working on their mobiles, remind them that Daniel and his friends did not want to eat the royal food. Their request was honored and they were later chosen to enter the king's service.
