



CRAFT/ACTIVITY: ANOINTING SCENE

Students will make a scene depicting Samuel as he anoints Saul with oil.

MATERIALS

- 1. 67 Lb. White Cardstock
- 2. Samuel & Saul Pattern
- 3. Crayons, Markers, or Colored Pencils
- 4. Scissors
- 5. Glue
- 6. Paper Plates



DIRECTIONS

- 1. Make a copy of the "Samuel & Saul Pattern" onto 67 lb. cardstock for each student.
- 2. Have students color the Samuel and Saul figures.
- 3. Allow students to cut out the two men and the shape that says "Samuel Anoints Saul".
- 4. Instruct students to glue the men and the shape that says "Samuel Anoints Saul" to the paper plate.

FOR DISCUSSION

As students are working on their anointing scene, help them understand that pouring oil on the head of Saul indicated that he was to be the king to rule over the Israelites.






