INTRODUCTION

GETTING STARTED

1. Share about the last time you had to follow the directions of a manual or computer app. What step caused you the most frustration? How far did you get until you had to ask for help? Who did you ask and why?

BIBLE IDEA

2. Read Acts 8:26-39. What specifically did Philip do after God told him to talk to the Ethiopian official (vs. 30, 31, 35, 36, & 39)? Based on this passage, create a possible step-by-step process for faith sharing. What part of the process could be hard for you to accomplish? Why?
3. Read Romans 10:13-17. How does faith begin (vs. 17)? List and discuss the logical progression Paul used to describe how people have opportunity to hear the Gospel (vs.14-15). How have you felt the Lord calling you to share your faith with others?
4. Read Acts 8:39-40. Based on his reaction after being baptized, what do you think the Ethiopian official did when he returned to his country? What did Philip immediately start doing after he was transported to the city of Azotus? What principles from this passage can you use today?
