Discussion Questions

INTRODUCTION

- 4. Read I Peter 1:3-5. Identify the four promises we can be thankful for because of Jesus. Which one has the most meaning to you? How can these promises sustain you during trial or hardship?
- 5. Read I Peter 1:6-7. Why do we go through trials? Share how God is refining you through trials and hardships.
- 6. Read I Peter 1:8-9. How would you personalize this passage? Write it out & share it.

7. In the next week, consider memorizing at least one verse from I Peter Chapter 1. Agree with a friend to do it together. Do you think people struggle with this? Why or why not? What benefits do you think might come with memorizing Scripture?
