Discussion Questions

INTRODUCTION

Imagine if God's Spirit were ignited within you. What would you do differently with your life?

GETTING STARTED

1. What ought a Christian, who is characterized by love and motivated by gratitude, look like?

BIBLE IDEA

- 2. Read Acts 1:8-9 & 2:1-13. What is the main reason Jesus promised the gift of the Holy Spirit (vs. 8)? What was the first miracle of the Holy Spirit (vs 2:4)? How did the followers respond?
- 3. Read Acts 2:14-24 & 36-39. How did the crowds respond to Peter's sermon? What parallels do you see in Joel's prophecy (vs. 17-21 given 600 years before) and the arrival of the Holy Spirit in Acts 2? What practical ways can you apply Peter's response to your daily life?
- 4. The Maturity of the Holy Spirit
 - a. Read Ezekiel 36:25-27. *The Holy Spirit transforms us.* Name three ways God transforms a person's life. How have you personally been transformed?
 - b. Read John 16:13-15. *The Holy Spirit leads us.* On whose authority does the Holy Spirit speak? What do you think is the key to being guided by the Holy Spirit?
 - c. Read Acts 1:8 & 1 Corinthians 2:2-5. *The Holy Spirit empowers us.* How does a person receive the power of the Holy Spirit (Acts 1:8)? What did Paul acknowledge, first, before actively demonstrating the Spirit's power (1 Corinthians 2:2-3)?
 - d. Read John 13:34-35 & Acts 2:42-47. *The Holy Spirt multiplies us.* Discuss the ways the early church community followed John 13:34. What was the result? (Acts 2:47)
