3. Read Luke 19:1-7. Why was Jesus passing through Jericho? Where was he ultimately heading? What do you know about the tax collectors of Jesus' time? What specific steps/choices did Zaccheus make before he encountered Jesus? How do you think this mirrors life today?
4. Read Ezekiel 34:11-16. Six hundred years before Jesus, God spoke these words through the prophet Ezekiel. Who do you think the "scattered sheep" are? How are you being led to help the Lord gather His sheep today? What might be holding you back?
5. Read Luke 19:8-10. How do you know Zaccheus experienced repentance? Share about a moment you witnessed repentance in someone else's life. What are some ways you can join Jesus' mission to seek and save the lost? How will you take action right now? Who would you like to invite on your team?
6. What are you hearing from the Holy Spirit right now?
