Discussion Questions

INTRODUCTION

We live in a world where people struggle to find true fulfillment. The normal routes people try are roadblocks. - 4. Do you think the disciples of Jesus felt fulfilled? Why, why not?
- 5. Has complacency, pursuit of comfort, or illusion of control ever kept you from an opportunity to make a difference? What were the circumstances? Have you every beaten these roadblocks? If so, how did you do it?

NEXT STEPS

- 6. Are there opportunities to make a difference that you might currently be missing? What would a full commitment to a divine purpose look like for you?
- 7. If you served with greater passion, what would people see you do or say differently? Are you willing to do something like this now?
