4. Read 2 Corinthians 10:3-4. What is intriguing about this passage as it applies to being prepared to fight?
5. Read Ephesians 6:10-20. Make a list of the armor/weapons God gives us for battle. Who is your real enemy? How are you using this armor?
6. Read Romans 8:31-39, Proverbs 3:5-6 & Isaiah 40:31. What are the promises that stand out to you? How can you **use** and **remember** these promises when you are in a spiritual battle?

7. What is God preparing for you to conquer this week? What one idea is He asking you to apply to your battle plan? How will you do this?
