- 2. Read Isaiah 6:1-8. Was Isaiah's response to God's holiness proper? Why or why not? Why do you think Isaiah accepted God's assignment? What principles could you apply today?
- 3. Focus on Isaiah 6:1. What were some of the similarities between the time of King Uzziah and today? Discuss how a follower of Jesus might navigate their faith in a changing and dark culture.
- 4. Read Hebrews 13:8, James 1:17 & Daniel 7:14. What do these passages have in common? What strength do you gain, knowing God will not change in... His opinion of you... His willingness to embrace all people... His plan of salvation... His strategy for the future... His foundational character of love & holiness... and His love for the church?
- 5. Read Ephesians 2:8-10. As a result of being given the gift of salvation, how might you respond to God? How does knowing you are "God's masterpiece" (NLT) help you discover and carry out God's call in a corrupt culture?
- 6. Read Esther 4:14. Esther was placed in a position of leadership at just the right time to save her people; what do you believe the Lord is calling you to do right now?
