2. Read Genesis 14:18-24 & Hebrews 7:1-4. Who was Melchizedek? What is the meaning of his name? Why do you think Melchizedek blessed Abram (Abraham)? How did Abram respond?
3. Read Genesis 15:1-6. How is the encounter with Melchizedek directly related with Moses' encounter with God? What does God say to Abram? What did God promise Abram? What are some ways you struggle trusting God with a tithe? What might you miss if you do not tithe?
4. Read Malachi 3:10-12. What is a tithe? What is promised when we tithe? What present day challenges prevent us from tithing?
5. Read 1 Corinthians 16:1-3. How were the churches in Corinth instructed to gather resources? Who were the churches in Corinth supporting? Do you see any correlations or principles for us today?
6. Read Matthew 6:19-21. What happens to treasures stored up with earthly intent? What is one of the best indicators of the condition of the heart?
