Discussion Questions

INTRODUCTION

- 4. Read Matthew 13:1-4;19 & Romans 2:19-23. Why is the world so deaf to Biblical truth (**concepts like:** the least is greatest, tithing, complete forgiveness, love/kindness, sacrificial service, surrender/submission, etc.)?
- 5. Matthew 13:5-6;20-21 & Romans 2:5-8. What is the difference between a casual Christian and a fully devoted follower of Jesus? Identify some ways God can melt a hard heart and open our ears to hear and follow His voice.
- 6. Read Matthew 13:7;22 & Hebrews 12:1-2. List some habits in your life that help you stay focused on Jesus. Which habit will you choose to focus on this week?
