Discussion Questions

INTRODUCTION

Life is filled with crossroads and dead-ends. Joshua is a model for how God uses obstacles to reveal Himself in powerful ways. What story might God be scripting for your life if you would answer His call?

GETTING STARTED

- 1. Think of a funny story. Why do you like sharing it? How often do you tell it?
- 2. Share about a time when you were asked to do something big? Were you ready? Were you afraid? How did you handle the pressure?

BIBLE IDEA

- 3. Read Joshua 3:1-17. How did God prove Himself faithful in this passage (vs. 14-17)?
- 4. Read Romans 12:1-2. What does it mean to offer your body "as a living sacrifice"? In what ways does this passage relate to Joshua 3:5?
- 5. Read Joshua 3:15-16. Imagine if you were at the river. How would you have felt? What would you have done?
- 6. Read Psalm 77:13-14. What miracles has God performed around you to remove obstacles from your life? How are you sharing this story with others?

NEXT STEPS

- 7. What is God doing **in you** right now? What is one step you can take in your life to cooperate with His direction?
- 8. Who can you share your miraculous story of God with this week? How do you think they will respond?
