INTRODUCTION

GETTING STARTED

1. Choose a song with the word 'love' in its title. Write out a line from the song that describes love. Is that phrase a good definition of love? Why or why not?
2. As a child, how did your family express love?
3. What do you think is the best expression of love that the world has to offer?

BIBLE IDEA

4. Come up with a consensus of the world's definition of love. Compare this to 1 John 4:7-12. How are they different or the same?
5. Read 1 John 4:7-12. Write out this passage using only five words. Why did you choose these words?
6. Read 1 Corinthians 13:4-8. Replace any reference to love with your name. Do the same with the name of Jesus. Discuss this exercise together.
7. Read 2 Corinthians 5:15, 20. Define what an ambassador is. In what ways can you improve being an ambassador for Jesus?

NEXT STEPS

8. Throughout the week look for opportunities to complete random acts of love. What might this look like to you? Each time, remember to thank Jesus for the chance to love someone in His name.
