Have you ever believed in something so much only to later find out you were completely wrong? What opened your eyes to the truth? How did you adjust your plans after discovering the truth?
3. Read Acts 9:3-9 & Proverbs 19:21. What happened to Saul's plan when he met the Lord on the road to Damascus? Besides his eyesight, what did the Lord take away from Saul?
4. Read Acts 9:10-17 & Romans 8:28. Knowing Saul's reputation, how did Ananias first react to God's prompting? How did the Lord specifically use Ananias to shape Saul's future? How is the Lord specifically using you to shape the future of someone? What excites you about this?
5. Read James 4:13-16. If life is like a vapor, how will you make the most of it? Who or what will you focus on and why? How might knowing that 'more life' is never promised, change the way you make plans and engage with people today?
