## INTRODUCTION

2. Share a time in your life when you joined forces with others to complete a huge task, finish a big event, or promote a wonderful cause. Who was with you? What were the obstacles? How did this experience add to your life?

3. Looking back at your notes from this week's teaching, was there anything you heard for the first time that caught your attention, confused you, challenged you, or made you curious?
4. Read Titus 3:12-15 & 2 Timothy 4:19-21. We may skim over these sections, yet Paul includes a list of cherished disciples in most of his letters. Who are these people and why does Paul give them this attention?
5. Read Matthew 25:14-30. Why do you think the master applauded the first two servants? Why did the last servant hide the money? How did the master describe this servant (vs. 26 & 30)? What observations in this parable apply to us today?
6. Read Romans 14:7-8 & Titus 3:14. Ultimately to whom do you belong? How often do you find yourself reflecting on this? What does a productive life look like? How does this affect the way you plan your days, spend your money, and focus your attention & effort?
7. What are you hearing from the Holy Spirit right now?
