5. In what way have you experienced life change as a result of your relationship to God? What did God do to demonstrate His power in you?

NEXT STEPS

6. How would you communicate the life change you've received because of your relationship with God? Would you describe it differently to a non-Christian than you would a Christian?
7. You can pray on another's behalf that God would demonstrate His power in them. Who do you want to pray for?
