## **INTRODUCTION**

Vision is about seeing. Vision can change you. Whether or not you consider yourself a visionary person, a vision of God can provide a person with incredible motivation and direction for living. It is the “So what?” of faith.

## **BIBLE IDEA**

3. Read Ephesians 1:15-21. Describe a time when the “eyes of your heart were enlightened” (v18). What did you experience and what impact did it make? If you have not, what might be possible reasons?
4. Sean said that the “seat of your life’s vision is the eyes of your heart.” Do you agree or disagree? Why?
5. When we see God, our vision changes. How does your vision of God affect how you see the world and see your future?
