# **Discussion Questions**

## **INTRODUCTION**

How do you see God? As a kind old man? Maybe as angry and judgmental? What if you instead built your perspective of God based on the truth of the Bible?

1. Discuss different ways people misperceive God. What might seduce us to view God without a biblically formed perspective?

- 2. Read Isaiah 6:1-4. What characteristic of God leaps off the page? Why do you think the seraphim (angels) covered their face? Are you comforted or terrified when thinking about God like this? Why?
- 3. Read 1 Chronicles 129:11-12 & 1 Timothy 1:17 & Psalm 9:7-8. Make a list of how the Lord is biblically distinct from all other creation. What phrase or thought stands out to you? Where do you see yourself compared to God? How does this affect your purpose and calling in life?
- 4. Read Exodus 15:11 & Revelation 15:4. Being that God, who is pure, complete, lacking nothing, and fully righteous, has called you to serve Him, how will you choose to respond?
- 5. Read Hebrews 1:3. In what way does this passage connect with Isaiah 6:1-4? How does the truth of knowing that Holy God became flesh sustain you as you interact with the world around you?
- 6. Read 1 Peter 1:13-16. What does being holy look like (vs 13)? How is living a life of holiness connected to the discovery of God's true nature of holiness?

7. With a correct view of God's holiness, what one step will you take this week to align yourself with His specific calling for your life?
