Discussion Questions

INTRODUCTION

- 4. How inclined are you to seek, allow, or speak of God doing things in supernatural ways? Have you experienced something in life that you'd characterize as God's supernatural activity? If so, describe it.
- 5. When Peter moved his attention away from Jesus, he fell victim to fear, and his progress was stalled. What are you fixated on that is cultivating fear? What would it mean for you to fix your attention on Jesus?

6. If you lived with greater faith this week, doing the impossible, what would you do? Are you ready to take action?

Matthew 14:22-33

²² Immediately he made the disciples get into the boat and go before him to the other side, while he dismissed the crowds. ²³ And after he had dismissed the crowds, he went up on the mountain by himself to pray. When evening came, he was there alone, ²⁴ but the boat by this time was a long way from the land, beaten by the waves, for the wind was against them. ²⁵ And in the fourth watch of the night he came to them, walking on the sea. ²⁶ But when the disciples saw him walking on the sea, they were terrified, and said, "It is a ghost!" and they cried out in fear. ²⁷ But immediately Jesus spoke to them, saying, "Take heart; it is I. Do not be afraid." ²⁸ And Peter answered him, "Lord, if it is you, command me to come to you on the water." ²⁹ He said, "Come."
