- 3. Read 1 John 1:8-10. What four consequences will we encounter if we claim to be without sin (vs. 8 & 10)? What will the Lord do **in us** if we confess our sins (vs. 9)? Talk about a time when the Lord washed your sins away.
- 4. Read Isaiah 64:8 & Isaiah 6:7-8. What was Isaiah's deepest need? How do you relate to this? What's your story of redemption?
- 5. Read Isaiah 6:8. What happened once Isaiah realized he was forgiven? What are some possible causes for people turning away from God's call? Share about a time when you turned away from God's calling & how He led you back.
- 6. Read John 14:16-17 & Acts 1:8. What is Jesus promising to His disciples (John 14:17)? What is the main reason we are given the power of the Holy Spirit (Acts 1:8)? What does 'being my witness' look like in your life? Specifically, where is the Lord leading you to be a witness as you are called?
