Discussion Questions

INTRODUCTION

As believers, we have a great responsibility and privilege to share how to find life and fulfillment through Jesus, yet we do not typically jump at the opportunity to share the Lord. What is it about sharing that seems to paralyze us in the midst of opportunity?

GETTING STARTED

- 1. Who do you care about enough *right now* to share with?
- 2. Why do we have a tendency to see the offense of other's sin? What would look different if we began to see their need, their hurt, and their brokenness rather than their offenses?

BIBLE IDEA

- 3. Read Mark 2:17. Do we really grasp what is at stake when someone does not know Christ? If you do understand, are your actions showing this urgency with sharing the gospel?
- 4. Matthew orchestrated a gathering with Jesus and His followers. We have a gathering of believers weekly; what is preventing you from inviting friends to *come* and see?
- 5. How did you feel when you witnessed the Master Plan for River City? Were you excited, nervous, disappointed etc.?

NEXT STEPS

- 6. We know that we will not share without caring and cannot care for those we do not know. How can you expand the circle of people you care about?
- 7. In what way can you step out and share your story? What would you say?
