Discussion Questions

- 5. 1 John 3:16-18 tells us the importance of serving one another. Why is it difficult to show love with our "world's goods"?

NEXT STEPS

- 6. Broken families and relationships show us a tainted picture of love, and hatred jeopardizes spending eternal life with Jesus. What changes need to be made in your life to begin avoiding these common offenses?
