Do you want peace?

Do you want to live a less anxious life?

Do you want to learn how to avoid falling into the enemy's traps, or playing into his hand ... again?

## **Prepare**

Be Humble

Where are you most in need of humility?

God's hand symbolizes discipline... (Ex 3:19; 6:1; Job 30:21; Ps 32:4) ... and deliverance (Dt 9:26; Eze 20:34)

Do Not be Anxious

He cares for you!

God will never give you more than \_\_\_\_\_ can handle!

### **Be Aware**

Be alert ... of sober mind...

What things are most likely to dull your awareness or make you un-alert?

- Liquid, chemical or vapor?
- Plenty or prosperity?

#### Remember

Our enemy the devil wants to devour and destroy you, so danger is all around.

But he cannot take away your salvation. (see: Romans 8:38-39)

The devil is defeated! ... even though he is still dangerous.

How might the devil try to feast on your effectiveness as a follower of Jesus?

#### Resist

Stand firm. Put on your armor to resist your real enemy.

You are not alone, your brothers and sisters suffer too. "And God is faithful... he will also provide a way out so that you can endure it." (1 Corinthians 10:13)

#### Restore

In this life God delivers us through our trials and sufferings not from them.

"[Jesus] saw two brothers, James son of Zebedee and his brother John. They were in a boat with their father Zebedee, <u>preparing</u> their nets." (Matthew 4:21)

Restore: Strong, Firm and Steadfast Prepare: ready to be used again

The Path to Peace through a Lion's Den is:

<u>Prepare - Be Aware - Remember - Resist - Restore - R</u>!

#### **Peace**

As you continue on the path you can have peace...

- His mighty hand will discipline and deliver you
- He cares for you and your anxieties
- He is victorious and your enemy is defeated
- He will restore you and prepare you to be used again
- He will come back to take you home one day
