

WAYS TO IMPACT A CHILD IN NEED

PRAY for them

• 14,000 children are currently in foster care in Pennsylvania. 2,000 of them are awaiting adoption into a forever home. Visit <u>dhs.pa.gov/AdoptPAkids/Pages/WaitingKids.aspx</u> to see photos and profiles of those waiting for adoptive families and pray for them.

SUPPORT those who support them

- Pray for adoptive and foster families.
- Use your gifts, resources, and skills to bless them.
- Come alongside them by providing meals, childcare, tutoring, clothing, or help with tasks/errands.
- Be part of a Care Community a team of people that provides regular support to an adoptive or foster family.

PROVIDE for their needs
