INTRODUCTION


I believe we NEED the book of Ephesians. Because in this book, it teaches us first to SIT, then WALK. Then take our STAND.

SIT (Ephesians 1:15-2:7)

What God Did in Christ

at the right hand of God the Father far above these guys! Christ died for our sins...te was buried...te was buried...

What God Did For US in Christ



Paul's Prayers (Ephesians 1:17-19a; 3:14-19)

WALK

I therefore, a prisoner for the Lord, urge you to **walk** in a manner worthy of the calling to which you have been called (4:1)

For we are his workmanship, created in Christ Jesus for good works, which God prepared beforehand, that we should **walk** in them. (2:10)


Now this I say and testify in the Lord, that you must no longer **walk** as the Gentiles do, in the futility of their minds.

Therefore be imitators of God, as beloved children. ² And walk in love, as Christ loved us and gave himself up for us, a fragrant offering and sacrifice to God. (5:1-2)


...for at one time you were darkness, but now you are light in the Lord. **Walk** as children of light... (5:8)

Look carefully then how you **walk**, not as unwise but as wise... (5:15)

Even though we are completely NEW in our spirits, we feel the impact of our broken body/soul. But while this brokenness is still felt, *it does not define who you are.* The *real* you is ALIVE in Christ!

STAND

Take your stand against the enemy! (6:10-20) but WALK before you STAND! (4:26-27)
