2 Samuel 23:20-23 (NLT)

A. Lion Chasers

- 1. Are aware of what they face.
- 2. Don't run from what they fear, they run toward it.
- 3. They understand that almost every physical challenge has a spiritual solution.
- 4. What are you going to do with the Lions in your life.
- 5. What is the craziest dream that you could go after.

B. God sized dreams

- 1. Will always be beyond you.
- 2. Will take you longer than you think, and be harder than you imagine.
- 3. If your dream doesn't scare you, your dream is too small.

C. Identify your dream

- 1. Do an inventory of your history.
- 2. Nothing is for nothing.
- 3. What makes you glad, mad or sad?
- 4. Get to your dream by serving someone else's dream.

D. Faith is the willingness to look foolish

- 1. If you aren't willing to look foolish to follow God's leading...you are foolish.
- 2. Make sure that it is God's will for your life. Sometimes we just need to take that step of faith.
- 3. Faith is unlearning our fears.

- 4. Cure for your fear of failure is failure in small doses.
- 5. Life is about obedience to the will of God.
