Text: Luke 7:36-50 (NLT)

A. Who was Mary?

- 1. An immoral woman.
- 2. The unwelcome guest, at Simon's house.
- 3. She was viewed as a hopeless sinner, not a person that needed to get right with God.
 - i. You can't know what is in a person's heart.
 - ii. It matters how we view people that come to this church.
- 4. She was the least welcome but loved Jesus the most.
- 5. She didn't allow anything to stop her from getting to Jesus.

B. Mary's Extravagant Love Gift.

- 1. She was overcome with emotion when she entered His presence.
 - i. Washed His feet with her tears (deep heart-wrenching sobs).
 - ii. Dried His feet with her hair.
- 2. She broke open her alabaster jar of expensive perfume.
 - i. One act of devotion/worship, probably all of her life savings.
- 3. The fragrance of her worship filled the room.
- 4. She would be remembered.

C. Not everyone will understand your extravagant worship.

1. Simon's response to Jesus vs Mary's.

- 2. The heart attitude is the most important part of worship.
- 3. Jesus deserved the highest measure of devotion.

D. Extravagant Worship brings a extravagant response for God.

- 1. Forgiveness of her many sins.
- 2. Remembrance in the Bible.
- 3. Example of love and devotion, from a generous heart.
- 4. The measure with which you sow is the measure of what you will reap.
- 5. Extreme love gets extreme response.
