A. God works the night shift.

- 1. Some of the most profound encounters with God have happened at night.
- 2. At night there is often less activity.

B. The Night Shift can also refer to a dark time of adversity.

- 1. It's also the time when there can be a shift in the spiritual trajectory of your life.
- 2. It's when adversity can cause us to turn to God.
- 3. The shift comes with an encounter with God.

C. Hearing God's voice at night.

- Listen for God's voice.
- 2. God called Samuel, but neither Eli or Samuel recognized the voice of the Lord.
- 3. It was the call outlining Samuel's destiny.
- 4. God calls us out of the ordinary to the extra-ordinary.

D. Don't miss it when God calls.

- 1. Ask God for clarification.
- 2. Act on it.
- 3. Be open to whatever God may have in mind for you.
