Text: Luke Chapter 2:1-7 (NLT)

A. The story of Christmas is really all about the most magnificent demonstration of love that the universe has ever seen.

- 1. The place where Jesus was born is an integral part of the Christmas story.
- 2. God's love in sending Jesus, is the one love that changes everything.
- 3. Christmas then...is really the story of <u>God's</u> love.
 - i. True Love is more than words...its always backed up by action.

B. God's Love Defined.

1 Corinthians 13:4-7 (NLT)

- 1. Is unconditional.
 - i. Understand that the cost of having to be right all the time is too costly.
 - ii. Are not people who take offense easily.
 - iii. Don't hold a **grudge.**
 - iv. Don't **stop loving** even when they have been wronged.
 - v. They Believe for the best in everyone.
- 2. Love is an inseparable part of God's character.

1 John 4:7-8 (NLT)

C. God's Love must be Accepted.

1. God desires relationship with us.

- 2. In order to accept God's love we must be able to forgive ourselves.
 - i. God's love for us is not dependent on our spiritual performance.

1 John 1:9 (NLT)

ii. God looks on our heart.

D. God's love is intended to be experienced.

- 1. You don't have to rid yourself of hurry or worry.
- 2. God's love can't be contained or constrained by any power in the universe, not evil, not death, no person or power.

Romans 8:38-39 (NLT)

3. Ask God to wrap his arms around you in this Christmas.

E. His love is the pattern for us to love one another.

1 John 4:9-11 (NLT)

- 1. What does that look like for you this season?
 - i. It should mean giving to someone who has no ability to give back to you in any way.
 - ii. It might mean forgiving someone who has hurt you or apologizing to someone you have hurt.
 - iii. Ask God for an opportunity to share God's love this week. Then keep your heart and eyes open for his response...recognize the opportunity and then act on it.
 - iv. Love someone enough to invite them to our Christmas eve service this weekend.
