A. The Meeting at Antioch:

1. The meeting included prophets, teachers, people from all walks of life.
2. Fasting increases the hunger for God and the sensitivity to his voice.
3. Worship creates the atmosphere for the Supernatural.
4. This was the event that turned the Church at Antioch upside down.

B. The Call of God:

1. The Holy Spirit said set apart Barnabas and Saul for the call I have on their lives.
2. The Holy Spirit has a voice and gives direction.

3. Prayer is the way that we put a contract on our God-given destiny.
4. After more fasting and prayer, Barnabas and Saul were commissioned with the laying on of hands.

C. Big things come from small beginnings.

1. All the churches Paul planted and the epistles he wrote have their origins in that service at Antioch.
2. The inclusion of the Gentiles into the plan of God came as a result of that service at Antioch.
3. What the Holy Spirit starts He empowers.
