2. They all recognized that only God could have done this.

3. Peter recognized that, he needed God's forgiveness and a fresh start.

E. God's call to service.

Luke 5:10b-11 (NLT)

- 1. The ability to serve the Lord does not come from within us.
- 2. God will provide all the resources that are needed.
- 3. God's call to service is always to *more* than you can ever imagine.
- 4. God is still doing the miraculous.
