- 1. He was of The Family of Levites.
 - i. His father was Jehoida of the priestly line of Aaron.

I Chronicles 11:22; I Chronicles 12:26

- ii. He carried a priestly anointing.
- 2. He was a warrior (2 of Moab's best men/an later a 7 1/2 ft. tall Egyptian).
- 3. He was eventually made commander of the entire army of Israel.

I Kings 2:34-35 (NLT)

4. Benaiah was a man who pursued his destiny.

C. What would give you enough confidence to chase a lion into a Pit on a snowy day?

- 1. There was a cause.
- 2. Lion Chasers know that their God is bigger than any Lion.
- 3. He had a history of success as God helped him.
- 4. Faith that God would give him victory over the Lion.
- 5. The doorway to our destiny also has lions in the way.

D. How do we get to our destiny?

- 1. There is a God-sized destiny for each of us.
- 2. Realize that we can carry also a priestly anointing.
