A. Bethlehem

- 1. Means...House of Bread/Ephrathah...Fruitfulness.
- 2. Was a small village with a population of about 1,000 people.
- 3. Was the birthplace of King David.
- 4. Was also the place where the sacrificial lambs used in the temple sacrifice came from.

B. God's Purpose for Bethlehem.

- 1. Never despise the small places in life.
- 2. From **Bethlehem** would finally come a **fit ruler**. For the entire nation of Israel.
- 3. The bread of life would be born there. Born to ordinary people in an ordinary place

C. The Road to Bethlehem, a Faith Journey.

- 1. The timing was according to prophecy.
 - i. The census by Augustas was when Mary was due.
 - ii. The Place was Bethlehem because Joseph was of the house and lineage of David.
- 2. Messiah would be trusted to an ordinary teenage couple.
 - i. Mary's Faith.

Luke 1:35 & 38 (NLT)

ii. Joseph's Faith.

Matthew 1:20-21 & 24-25 (NLT)

- 3. The Road to Bethlehem.
 - i. The road from Nazareth to Bethlehem was, 70-80 miles.
 - ii. When they got there they must have been cold hungry and tired.
 - iii. Faith is what it takes to bring you to your destiny.
 - iv. Don't give up!
