Text: Ezekiel 47:7-8 & 12 (NLT)

A. The River of life originates in the presence of God.

- 1. God alone is the source of this living water. Nothing else can do what God can do.
- 2. No other influence can give the life that we are talking about here.
- 3. You will seek the river when:
 - i. You are totally convinced that there must be something more to life.
 - ii. When you get desperate for the presence of God.

B. Wherever the River flows there is dramatic change.

Ezekiel 47:8b (NLT)

- 1. Where the living water that flows, that which is dead, and smells bad, and is toxic to all life...is brought to life.
- 2. All kinds of life will flourish wherever this supernatural water flows.

C. Wherever the River flows there is provision.

Ezekiel 47:12 (NLT)

- 1. The trees planted by the river will always produce fruit in every season.
- 2. There will be a new crop of fruit every month.
- 3. This fruit will be the perfect food. (Manna)
- 4. This fruit will satisfy all of our needs.

Philippians 4:19 (NLT)

D. Wherever the River flows there is Healing.

- 1. Healing is a part of our spiritual inheritance. (Matthew 15:26)
- 2. God's healing is always available: He is always attentive to our cry...24/7 365 days a year.
- 3. No need for healing is beyond hope for the giver of life itself.
- 4. Ask God how to pray, when to pray the prayer of faith, and leave the results to God.

E. The Challenge.

- 1. Miracles always point to Jesus.
- 2. Become a carrier of the water of Life.
- 3. Ask God for the strategy to influence your neighborhood and community.
 - i. Pray over our neighborhoods.
 - ii. Ask God to show you the needs.
- 4. Be a part of meeting those needs as directed by God.

Proverbs 11:24-25 (NLT)

5. Find a way to have an influence in your community.

Conclusions: Wherever the river flows there is life, where it does not flow, the water will stay stagnant.

God will give "to us" if he can get it "through us".
