Grace Church will hold an AED defibrillator training session on Sunday, June 4 after the morning worship service. An AED (Automated External Defibrillator) is an apparatus used to help those who are experiencing sudden cardiac arrest. Our teacher on that morning will be Jake LaForet, Battalion Chief with the Upper Perkiomen Valley Ambulance Station 369; he is an instructor with the American Heart Association for CPR, AED, and first aid. The class will run about a half-hour and will include how to use the AED and how to administer CPR.
