Sunday School Classes starting on March 17

Class 1 (Room 113-115) – Part 1: 3/17 to 4/28; Part 2: 5/5 to 6/2.

- Part One: From Passover to the Lord's Table (Duane Moyer). Jesus' last Passover meal with his disciples was a Seder like they had never celebrated before. What would they have remembered, and what can we learn as we look at the Lord's Table from their perspective?
- Part Two: How to live a Christian Life: Studies in Romans 12 (Jim Roberts). In the early years following Christ's ascension, believers in Jesus were referred to as followers of "the Way." We still have a way to follow today. We will look specifically at what Romans 12 has to say about presenting our minds and bodies as "living sacrifices" in our daily Christian walk.

<u>Tips for being a bad leader: Studies in the book of Judges</u> (Bryan Maier). We hear a lot these days about what constitutes a good leader but many leaders in the Bible are better role models of what makes for a bad leader.
