



### Luke 23:18,20,23-24,32-33 (NLT)

Then a mighty roar rose from the crowd, and with one voice they shouted, "Kill him, and release Barabbas to us!"...Pilate argued with them, because he wanted to release Jesus....But the mob shouted louder and louder, demanding that Jesus be crucified, and their voices prevailed.
