INTRODUCTION

The early Church was not built around consumers, preferences, personalities or programs. It was built around devotion to Scripture, community, prayer, generosity, worship and witness to others what Jesus did and taught.

INTRODUCTION: *DISCOVER*

Use this week and the following directive to create a home or devotion to God's Word, God's Will and God's Way this week.

SCRIPTURES TO REMEMBER → Acts 2:42 (ESV)

⁴² And they devoted themselves to the apostles' teaching and the fellowship, to the breaking of bread and the prayers.

DISCUSSION QUESTIONS: *DEVELOP + DO*

Monday // Devotion to God's Word

- Read Acts 2:42-47. This passage explains what the church was devoted to and what that looked like. Which devotion stands out the most to you and why? (CONSIDER: Devotion to the Apostles' teaching, to fellowship, to breaking of bread or prayer)
- What would devotion to that look like in your life today? (Ex. committing to reading the Bible on a daily basis.)

Tuesday // Devotion to Fellowship

- Today, invite a small group member, friend, family member, or co-worker and check on how they are doing. Listen for “hurts” or “hesitations” in areas where they may have a struggle. End the call/time together praying with them about that.

Wednesday and/or Thursday // Devotion to Breaking of Bread

- Use today to invite someone to share a meal or communion. During your time together, invite them into a conversation about Jesus by asking, “Have you ever been in “awe” or “amazement” of something God did? Use the conversation to share your testimony of how you have experienced God in your life.

Friday and Saturday // Devotion to Prayer

- Today, start your morning by reading Acts 2:42-47 and praying to God. Use the A.C.T.S. model if you need a model to follow, or simply thank God for what He has done and ask Him to prepare your heart and mind for doing His will today in your life. (*A.C.T.S. MODEL: A = Adoration for God; C = Confess sins; T= Thank God for what He has done; S = Supplication - ask God for His will to be done in your life where you need Him*)
