### **SERMON: Disciple**

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#### **Introduction**

The life of Simon Peter is a perfect case study for what it means to be discipled by Jesus. At CrossPointe Church, we believe that our Discover, Develop, and Do model encapsulates that journey of faith!

#### **Key Scriptures**

- Luke 5:1-11 (Peter Discovers who he is and who Jesus is)
- Matthew 14:22-33 (Jesus Develops Peter's faith by allowing him into the storm)
- John 21:4-8,15-19 (Jesus challenges Peter to Do life just as He had)
- 1 Peter 5:1-5 (Peter issues the same challenge to Do to a new generation of disciples)

#### **Discussion Questions**

1. In your own words, what does it mean to be a disciple?
2. At what point in your life did you begin to consider yourself a disciple of Christ?
3. Talk about the moment when you realized who you really were and why you needed Jesus.
4. If you are really brave, tell your group what things made you think you could not follow Jesus.
5. Have you ever been in a situation that felt like a "storm" but you felt sure that God had sent you into it?
6. In that "storm" or another, did you ever feel called to go farther into the storm, like Peter did?
7. Share with your group what that storm moment did for your faith, once you realized that Jesus always had control of your life.
8. Is there any place in your life that you feel called to "Do" right now?
9. What have you let stop you from "Doing" in the past when you felt the pull of the Holy Spirit? It does not have to be a huge, life-altering event. It may be a time that you knew you should have made a call that you never did.
10. In your life, who is counting on you to be faithful to Jesus' call to "Do"?
