



DISCUSSION QUESTIONS

Read Matthew 2:1-12. Then use these questions with your small group, family, friends to keep Sunday's conversation going.

1. Sunday Josh said, "What's important, gets repeated!" How have you seen that play out firsthand in your life?
2. The wise men traveled a great distance and endured hardship to find Jesus; what does their determination reveal about the true cost of worship, especially when compared to Herod's focus on maintaining personal power?
3. The chief priests and scribes identified Jesus's birthplace using scripture, but they didn't go to worship Him. How does their knowledge without action challenge us today?
4. The wise men offered gifts and changed their plans based on a warning. How willing are we to re-route our lives based on God's guidance?
5. King Herod reacted to the news of a new king with fear and violence. What are some modern anxieties or insecurities that cause people to reject Christ's authority?

Each group had an encounter with information about the newborn King, but only one group worshiped Him. How does the story of these three groups serve as a mirror for our own hearts when faced with the truth of Jesus?
