INTRODUCTION: *DISCOVER*

Let's discuss the interaction Jesus had with Pilate, Herod and His impact on Barabbas.

SCRIPTURES TO REMEMBER → Luke 23:25 (ESV)

²⁵ He released the man who had been thrown into prison for insurrection and murder, for whom they asked, but he delivered Jesus over to their will.

DISCUSSION QUESTIONS: *DEVELOP*

1. **In Sunday's message, Josh explained how communication consists of "what is said", "how it is said", "what is heard" and "how it is heard".** What is the most challenging part of communication for you in a conversation?
2. **Read Luke 23:1-5. The religious leaders bring false charges against Jesus.** How do we know their charges are false? Have you ever experienced someone bringing false accusations against you or someone you care about? How did that make you feel?
3. **In Sunday's message, Josh said Jesus's response to Pilate led them to discuss the Kingdom of God.** How challenging is it for you to stop and consider your "response" before you "react" to others in a conflict?
4. **Read Luke 23:8-9. Then read Isaiah 53:6-7. Herod wanted to see a sign, but Jesus remained silent.** What does Jesus's response to Herod (silence and no sign), tell you about Jesus?
5. **In Sunday's sermon, Josh explained that we have all sat in a similar chair as Pilate (nonbelieving), Herod (should believe) and Barabbas (the guilty).** How does your past "seat" impact the way you communicate your faith to people today?
