

Question: How would you respond if Jesus spoke directly to your church this way?


"We can't always keep looking back at past experiences. We need to continually mature in our relationship with Christ just like we need to continually mature in the other relationships in our life."

2. They Lost their Love


Rev 2:2-4


3. So, how do we change this?

Eph 3:17 Then Christ will make his home in your hearts as you trust in him. Your roots will grow down into God's love and keep you strong.

As Believers, we must grow______into the love of Christ so we can grow stronger.

Question: How can I grow deeper in God's love?

Eph 4:14-15 Then we will no longer be immature like children. We won't be tossed and blown about by every wind of new teaching. We will not be influenced when people try to trick us with lies so clever they sound like the truth. (15) Instead, we will speak the truth in love, growing in every way more and more like Christ, who is the head of his body, the church.
